What Is A land trust

- A 501c3, **not for profit**, Corporation
 - Approved to act as a proxy for the IRS
 - IRS Code reference; Section 170h, Charitable Contributions
- Determines a properties suitability for Conservation
 - Habitat, unique flora and fauna
 - Riparian zones
 - Scenic value
 - Public access
- Drafts and records Conservation Covenants in a Permanent Deed of Conservation
- Monitors the property for compliance in perpetuity

CONSERVATION EASEMENTS can be a valuable financial tool...

- Creates Federal & State income tax deductions
 - 50% AGI, from 5 to 15 years
- Property tax reductions
- Reduce net purchase cost of property
- Provide cash for expansion of land holdings
- Preserve esthetic quality & value of surrounding property



Conservation Easements...Clearing the Air

Designed by Congress to encourage public / private partnerships in the protection of our country's natural resources.

- Perpetual protection of land's conservation value
- Completely customizable to landowner needs
- Passive recreation, agriculture, ranching and forestry can continue
- Significant economic benefits as compensation for foregoing future development rights
 - Federal & State income tax deductions
 - 50% AGI, up to 15 years

- Investors can inject private capital to conserve
- Allows investors to share in tax deduction rewards
- Produces a real ROI for investors of 100+%
